St David's Class Curriculum Overview Summer 2 2023

English – We will be reading 'Stig of the Dump' as our class text. As we read the text, we will be analysing the content including archaic words. We will focus on the character development of Stig and Barney. Our writing tasks will focus on descriptions of the characters and setting, diary writing and storytelling.

History/Geography: Castles – We will be learning about Motte and Bailey castles alongside researching castles in the local area.

Science – Plants

In this unit we will be identifying & naming parts of a plant and know their functions. We will be learning about pollination and plant life cycles as well as investigating conditions for growth. Music- Our music work will be based on a unit of work – Blackbird by the Beatles. We will listen to different genres of music and discuss our likes and dislikes. We will learn to read notation and play simple songs on the glockenspiel. We will listen to each other perform. We will also Reflect, Rewind and Play again aspects of our music learning across the year.

Maths

Summer 2

Y3 – The children will be working on the following concepts – developing their undertsanding and reasoning – Time, Properties of Shape, Statistics, Position and Direction.

Y4 – The children will be working on the following concepts – developing their undertsanding and reasoning – Fractions, Money, Time, Properties of Shape

Art – The focus is wildlife and in particular, birds. We will be drawing and looking at different techniques to add definition and detail. We will also look at printing and pattern making, using the natural world as an influence.

RE – What is it like to follow God? We will be looking at some of the Old Testament Prophets & their relationship with God. We will be making links with how Christians live their lives today.

French– We will learn vocabulary linked to My Family and Friends.

PSHE – Safety First

In this unit of work, children will consider what it means to take responsibility for their own safety. Thinking about how to stand up to peer pressure. They will learn about everyday risks, hazards and dangers and what to do in risky or dangerous situations. They will learn about road safety and dangerous substances; drugs (including medicines), cigarettes and alcohol. Children will look at e-Safety, considering what should never be shared and how to report any concerns about online incidents.
