

St David's Class Curriculum Overview Spring 2

English – We will be reading a variety of poems about Spring. We will read 'I wandered lonely as a cloud' by Wordsworth and discuss his style of poetry writing. We will write our spring poems taking inspiration from our environment. We will practise our handwriting, learning joins and ensuring letter formation is correct. Spellings will be set on a Monday and tested on a Friday.

ICT– Touch Typing (Y3) and Writing for different audiences (Y4)

PE – Gymnastics (Friday)

PE – swimming at Willowburn (Thursday)

PSHE Britain – the children will identify similarities and differences between lifestyles, situations and experiences in our country and how they fit in to our community.

Science – We will be finding out about electricity; Keeping Safe using electricity, how you build a circuit, what an insulator and conductor are, how electricity is used in industry. We will apply our learning to our DT models.

Music – We will listen to different genres of music and discuss our likes and dislikes. We will revisit notation and perform songs on the glockenspiel. We will find out what scales are on the keyboard.

Spring 1



Maths – Both Y3 and Y4 groups will consolidate their previous learning about multiplication and division before moving onto length and measure. Y4 will calculate perimeters and then move onto fractions.

Year 3 will extend their measuring to include different units of measure. With all aspects of maths, applying it to real life situations is important. At home, please help your child with understanding time and recognising simple times such as o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to.

D&T– We will create electrical circuits to use within a model of a lighthouse. We will plan, design and evaluate our models.

RE – We will find out why Christians call Good Friday 'Good' when it is a sad day to remember. We will listen to the Easter story and take part in our Easter Service in church.

French – We will learn numbers up to 30. Then we will learn how to address different family members.

History: Anglo Saxons

We will learn when the Anglo Saxons invaded Britain and the legacy they left behind. We will find out how they used to live, what they ate and how we know about them using artefacts and images.
