Over the summer break we spent a significant amount of money on the school kitchen through our Developed Formula Capital Fund (additional money to the school budget for infrastructure) and energy efficiency funding from the DfE.

Mrs Hinson and Miss Dodds have been working extremely hard to get to know the new equipment – push through dishwasher, Combi-oven and a multi-functional cooking system (iVario).

Class Worships

We are going to re-introduce class worships this year (if your family attended Longhoughton before COVID then you might remember these!). Parents, with children in the class leading the worship, will be invited to come in and join that worship.
