### Reading Books

It will really help them next year. Spellings are on the website every Monday night should your child forget their folder, as well as a brief explanation of what the children will be doing in maths and English that week.

### PE Kits and Uniforms

Please remember to name all of the children's clothing. Our days for P.E. will continue to be on a Monday and Thursday.

### Snacks and Drinks

Snacks can be fruit, healthy cereal bars and plain biscuits. If you send a snack into school, please avoid chocolate covered snacks. **Could you also make sure that the children have a water bottle that stays in school Monday to Friday.** We will send it home every Friday for a wash. Please remember that we are a healthy school and we only allow plain water in their classroom water bottles.

Now that the weather is warmer, it would be useful if the children had sun cream in school. Please don't also forget coats. Northumberland weather can change very quickly and we don't want children standing in doorways so they don't get wet because they came to school without a coat. Unless it is pouring, we will always try to get the children outside for fresh air during playtimes.
