

Activities to make spelling fun!

Choose a different activity to complete at least four times per week. You may not repeat the same activity twice in one week.

<p>Rainbow Write</p> <p>First write the words using a pencil. Then go over each letter of the word using a different coloured pencil /pen.</p>	<p>Silly Sentences</p> <p>Write a silly sentence using each of your spelling words.</p>	<p>Hidden Words</p> <p>Draw and colour a picture. Hide your spelling words within the picture. See if someone can find the hidden words.</p>	<p>ABC Words</p> <p>Write your spelling words in an alphabetic order list.</p>
<p>Fancy Words</p> <p>Write your words using fancy letters.</p> <p><i>Catch</i> CATCH</p>	<p>Three Times</p> <p>Write each word in pencil. Then write each word in pen. Finally write each word in crayon.</p>	<p>UPPER lower</p> <p>Write each word one at a time using capital letters then using lower case letters.</p>	<p>Words within Words</p> <p>Write out your spellings. Can you find words within words? Car and red in scarred</p>
<p>Words without vowels</p> <p>Write all of your words replacing the vowels with a line Go back and see if you can fill in the vowels. sc_rr_d (scarred)</p>	<p>Read, cover, write</p> <p>Read the word, cover it up, write it.</p>	<p>Mnemonics</p> <p>Can you create a mnemonic for your spelling? said - Sally always is dancing. because - big elephants always upset small elephants</p>	<p>Questions or sentences</p> <p>Can you write your spellings in a question or sentence?</p>
<p>Charades</p> <p>Can you act out your spelling? Once someone has guessed it, you have to spell it.</p>	<p>Syllables</p> <p>Practise your spellings by breaking it down into syllables. chim-pan-zee</p>	<p>Word Search</p> <p>Google creating word searches. They will put your spellings into a word search or you can make your own.</p>	<p>Crosswords</p> <p>Google creating crosswords. They will put your spellings into a crossword or you can make your own.</p>
